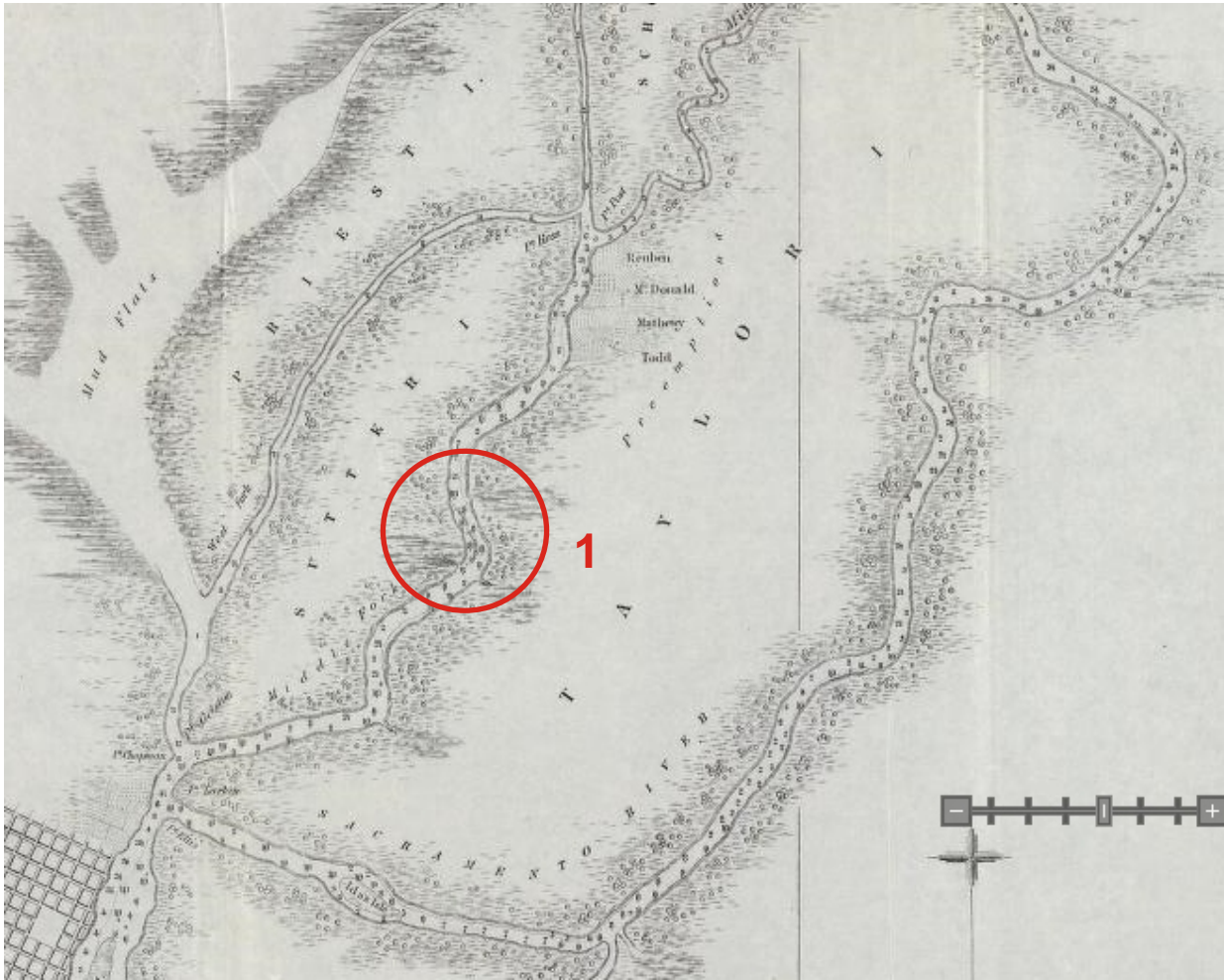


Comparison of 1852, 1906, 1935 and 2009 maps showing “Hogsback Shoal” and Snug Harbor



1 Portion of 1852 Navy map showing the location of Hogsback Shoal in the Middle Fork of the Sacramento River. Island to the west is Sutter and to the east is Taylor.

2. Portion of 1906 USGS survey. Note the island names have changed to Ryer and Grand, and the waterway is referred to as Steamboat Slough.

3. Portion of 1935 USGS Soils Map survey, with the word “boundary” slightly lightened so the island can be better seen.

4. MSN map, which reflects recorded Solano County maps, shows the land today as Snug Harbor Drive. An area 1.5 miles north of Snug Harbor is called “Hogback Island Park” even though its not the original Hogsback Shoal.
