


# SITE LAYOUT AND LOCAL SERVICES

**RV SITE LAYOUT & ADDITIONS:**

1. Only the BBQ, firepit and table can be left outside your RV when you are not currently staying onsite. Lawn chairs must be stored in or under your RV, out of view. Firewood must be stacked neatly near the firepit/BBQ.
2. Items like bikes, coolers, paddle boards, lighting, etc must be stored in or under the RV, out of site, when you are not there and actively using such items. If you plan to store items under your RV, you need to have a "skirt" or visual barrier to hide the items from view. Note that Snug Harbor is in a flood zone and items kept under trailer or in storage onsite could be damaged or ruined due to flood. Leaseholder must insure own personal items. SHR not responsible for damage due to flood, earthquakes, fires, pandemics and illegal acts of others.
3. If you wish to add outdoor storage unit of no larger than 3'x6', get written permission from management for the placement of storage unit, which must be placed flat against the RV, not free standing. Storage unit must be removed from the site if the RV is removed from the site. Monthly and short term rentals may not add storage units outside the RV.
4. If you wish to add paving stones or a deck, first get written permission from management. Monthly and short term leases can not add decks, but can use a lawn carpet if not tacky looking.
4. If you have a second vehicle on lease, please park it in your site. If it does not fit, ask management for a specific alternate parking site. Do not park in any other RV site for any amount of time.
5. You may not park a boat or boat trailer in the site unless it is temporary to unload supplies. You may not work on boats in the site.
6. No tents are allowed in any RV site.
7. Due to the high cost of well water, you may not add plants, bushes or trees to the site, and may not add drip system or water sprayers as this will result in your excessive use of expensive treated drinking water.
8. Use dusters and wet cloth to wash the exterior of RV. Pressure washer use is not allowed more than once per year due to high cost of treated water. River water for washing may be available.
9. Do not change site line barriers or add fencing without written permission.
10. Your garbage can must be accessible to put out, if you are using local garbage pick up service. You and family/friends may NOT use park refuse disposal bins or cans. Do not leave large items for us to throw out.
11. If you will be using propane tank, it must be secured to your RV, usually the trailer tongue, or secured to the ground at the side of RV. SHR is in a flood zone and it is a very important safety measure that all propane tanks are secured so they do not float away.
